### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-12*.
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.

#### 2.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all registered and measured International OK Dinghy class boats, the skipper of which must be financial members of the New Zealand OK Dinghy Association and members of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.

- 2.3 Entries will be accepted until 9:45am on Saturday 22 October 2011, by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of **\$60** and presenting the entry on the day, or posting it to PO Box 32-288, Devonport at least one week prior.
- 2.3 For the purposes of NZ Tour points, and Worlds team selection points:
- § Each boat must have a valid measurement certificate which must be presented on registration.
  - § Every sail used in the contest must have been measured and signed by an official measurer.
  - § There will be random checking of weights and correctors of hulls and masts throughout the contest at the discretion of the race committee/NZOKDA.
  - § All gear must be legal prior to and during the contest.
  - § Breach of the above provisos by any competitor will result in that competitor receiving no ranking points for this contest and not being entitled to count this contest towards 2012 OK Worlds NZL team selection.

### **3.0 Schedule of Events :**

- 3.1 *Racing Schedule: The following times are for the warning signal for each start.*

Briefing: 10.00 am

Race 1: 11.30 am

Races 2–5: To Follow

#### **Sunday 23 October 2009**

Race 6: 10.00 am

Races 7–10: To Follow

**Prize Giving, Prize Giving Dinner and Rum Party** (including watching a certain **RUGBY MATCH**) will be in the WBC clubrooms following completion of last race.

**Saturday 22 October 2009:** Dinner in Devonport (venue to be confirmed).

#### **Sunday 25 October 2009:**

- (a) **Prizegiving** at Wakatere Boating Club.

- (c) **Watching a certain rugby match** after dinner.
- (d) **Filling and emptying the Rum Bucket** (following prizegiving and continuing throughout the evening ).

#### **4.0 Sailing Instructions**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

#### **5.0 Racing Area**

The races will be held in Rangitoto Channel **NORTH** of Narrowneck Beach.

#### **6.0 Courses to be Sailed**

The course will be Triangle, Windward/Leeward or a combination. Course diagrams will be supplied with the Sailing Instructions.

#### **7.0 Scoring**

7.1 The Low-Points scoring system will apply.

7.2 **10** Races are scheduled. **2** races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.3 When **5** or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.4 All boats will race together and be scored as one fleet.
